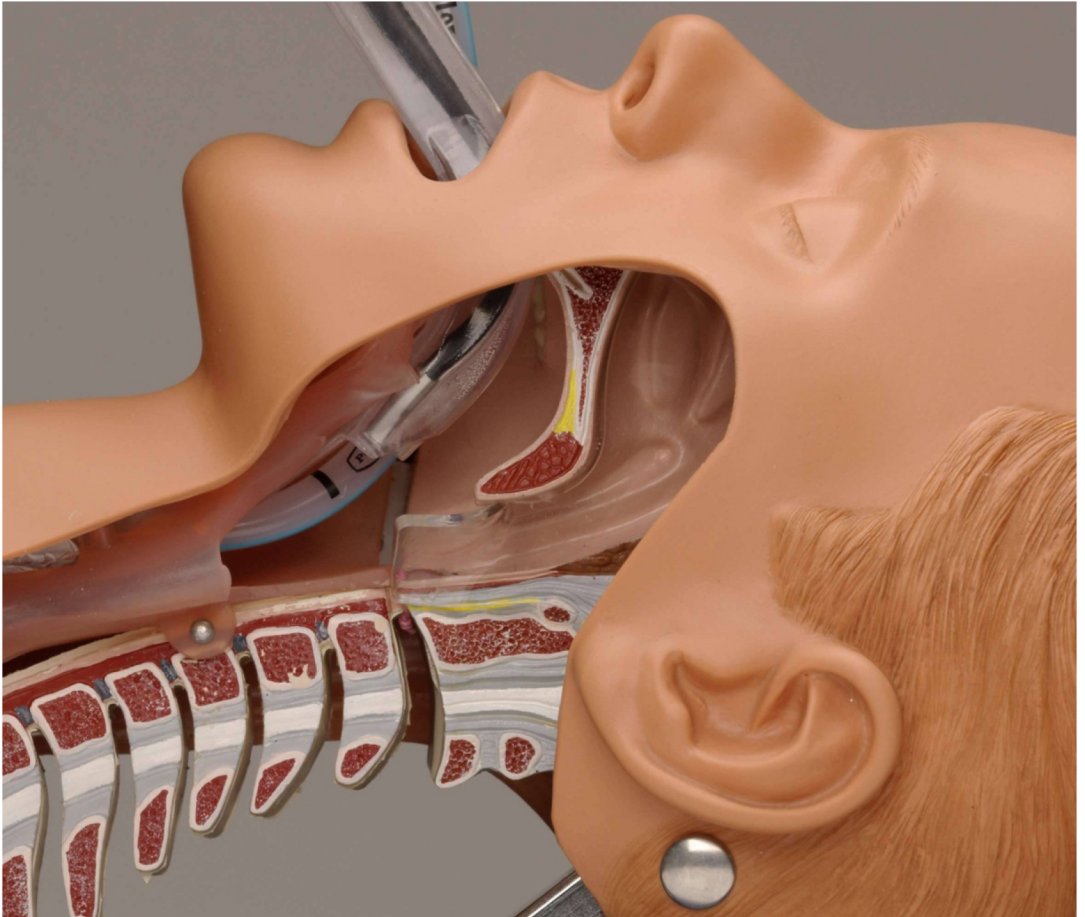


Airway Management



Airway Management

Airway Management skills are critical in saving the life of victims who experience hypoxia due to airway obstruction. Improving skills to identify a compromised airway and maintaining airway patency can help bring down death rates. The aim of this module is to train nurses on various challenging airway management techniques with the purpose of maintaining and restoring a safe and effective pathway for oxygenation and ventilation.
